
CHELSEA YOUTH CLUB

DOGGETT'S COAT AND BADGE RACE

Cadogan Pier continues to host the finish line celebrations for The Doggett's Coat & Badge Race. The Race has been running since 1715 and is the world's oldest rowing race. In 2021 we hosted two events, to include the delayed 2020 event, and the 2021 event. We look forward to hosting them for the 2022 race.

The artists enjoy taking advantage of the unique vista of the Thames that they get from the Pier. Our team supply them with drinks and snacks during the day which was much appreciated in the heat of their last visit.

UBER BOAT BY THAMES CLIPPER

Users of Uber Boat from Cadogan Pier continue to rise. The timetable has been extended and there are now almost 30 timetabled stops a day at the Pier. The river is a wonderful way to commute or to see London as a tourist and we are very happy to promote this at Cadogan Pier.



INVESTMENT IN THE MOORINGS

Our team has been working very hard on cosmetic improvements at Chelsea Yacht & Boat Company and Cadogan Pier. We have made significant investment in several areas including:

- Improved lighting, security, engineering, access and signage.
- Increased the frequency of the Uber Boat by Thames Clipper and installed a display screen for river bus arrival times.
- Replaced flags and signs on both Piers.
- Stopped the practice of double parking boats, which had previously taken place and was a danger to boats.
- Dedicated Full Time Pier Master on Cadogan Pier.
- CYBC and Cadogan Pier have dedicated and loyal teams both of which have been expanded over the last 2 years.
- CYBC is able to offer a wide range of boat related improvement, build and maintenance services, with a team of highly skilled and experienced craftsmen.
- CYBC is home to one of the largest dry docks on the central Thames.
- At both Piers we have invested in and renovated pontoons.
- Ensured that the Piers continue to be maintained and serviced from the river rather than the road.
